Thursday Daytime Mixed 9:00 and 11: 00 a.m.

Open to team entries composed of any combination of men and women.

Thursday Night Men's - 6:45 and 9:00 p.m.

Open to team entries composed of men of any age.

Little Rockers

Curling for members who are 8 to 12 years of age. Children curl using smaller granite rocks in order to develop the mechanics of a good delivery. Instruction and fun are key components. Please note, adults bringing children to Little Rockers must be responsible for them for the duration of the curling session. We ask that the children wear a helmet.

Fall Session - Nov 11, 2018, Nov 25, 2018, Dec 2, 2018 and Dec 16, 2018

Winter Session - Jan 6, 2019, Jan 20, 2019, Feb 3, 2019 and Feb 17, 2019

All above sessions are Sundays and commence at 1:00 pm

Junior Curling

Junior curling is open to youths 12 to 15 years of age. This assists young curlers in developing the skills and learning the rules of the game required to participate in league and more competitive play. Juniors may also curl in any evening event, however an additional membership fee ("Student") is applicable. Junior Curling dates are; Nov 11, 2018, Nov 25, 2018, Dec 2, 2018 and Dec 16, 2018, Jan 6, 2019, Jan 20, 2019, Feb 3, 2019 and Feb 17, 2019

All above sessions are Sundays and commence at 1:00 pm

New Adult Learn to Curl - contact any member of the membership committee, the sessions are free and available November 9, November 23, December 7 and January 4. The sessions begin at 7 pm and go till 9 pm.

Curl Funspiel- Dec 1 - enter as a team or as individuals, we will find skips and set up teams that day, entry fee is \$10 and is open to all members of Glencoe Curling Club and friends. (non-members will cost \$25).

50-50 / Luxury Draw - is when you pay the 50-50 fee (\$20.00) up front for the season, and your name is guaranteed to be in the draw on a weekly basis. This is open to all members paying a "Full Membership" .If you would like your name to be entered into this draw this season, please add \$20 to your membership fee and indicate this on the membership form in the appropriate location.

**Payment Options**

Membership payment is due upon commencing curling. As per the club constitution "Any member negligent in dues payment over 30 days shall be barred from participation in club activities."
